LAHONTAN AUDUBON SOCIETY'S BIRDS OF THE TRUCKEE MEADOWS CLASSES

Spring has sprung and the birds are back. Once again, Lahontan Audubon Society presents its **Birds of the Truckee Meadows** series of bird identification classes. Learn how to tell a kestrel from a buteo, a sparrow from a jay, **AND WHAT THE HECK ARE the BIRDS ABOVE?**

The classes will be from **6 to 8 p.m.** on **Wednesdays starting April 26**, in **Reno**, at **Moana Nursery's Landscape and Design Center**, 1100 West Moana Lane, near the southwest corner of Lakeside Drive and Moana Lane.
